Introducing the Virtual Health Information Network (vhin.co.nz) - a network for sharing and collaboration among researchers using health data, this talk will draw on learnings from Healthier Lives research done in Stats NZ's Integrated Data Infrastructure, a large research database of linked microdata about people and households. We will talk about the impact of Canterbury earthquake damage on heart disease and give an early update on studies examining cancer prevalence, productivity costs of heart disease and protective factors against the progression of pre-diabetes to diabetes.
